Our vision is to create self-reliant groups within these communities, fostering holistic development and empowerment. Our core values include promoting gender justice, enhancing women and child healthcare, ensuring food security, poverty alleviation, and sustainable livelihood through micro-enterprise development.

Our major programs encompass Women Empowerment, Community Health, Climate Action, Digital Education, and Gender Justice. We aim to support 36 semi-orphan and underprivileged children in Varanasi, alongside engaging with men and boys for gender equality. Our target communities span across Azamgarh, Ambedkar Nagar, and Varanasi.



Collaborating with partners like Azim Premji Foundation, Rebuild India/Dasra, and eVidyaloka Trust, we strive to build a self-sufficient rural society capable of achieving true Gram Swaraj (Local self Governance). Our principles revolve around mutual respect, equality, equal opportunities, transparency, dedication, self-discipline, and responsibility.

Gramin Punarnirman Sansthan-GPS is legally registered under the Societies Registration Act, holds 12A and 80G certifications under the Income Tax Act, and is compliant with FCRA and CSR-1 regulations. Our work is deeply rooted in empowering women, children, adolescents, men, and marginalized farmers through advocacy, education, and community-based initiatives in Azamgarh, Ambedkar Nagar, and Varanasi. Together, we strive to make a lasting impact on gender equality, community health, and sustainable development.

Our commitment to social change drives our operations, and we remain dedicated to our cause of uplifting the marginalized sections of society. Engaging with stakeholders and policy-makers, we continue to champion for the rights and voices of the underprivileged, fostering a more inclusive and empowered society.

Enabling women from marginalized communities to have access over government schemes through local governance system.-ERW

The Gramin Punarnirman Sansthan program has been instrumental in empowering women from marginalized communities, enabling them to access various government schemes through the local governance system. The main objectives of the program are to create an enabling environment for women's empowerment and inclusion, promote the effective realization of entitlements for eligible families, and ensure active participation of women collectives in Gram Sabha meetings.



One of the key highlights of the program is the monthly meetings held by the Mahila Sangathan and Nari Sangh, where discussions on current schemes, eligibility criteria, required documents, application processes, and women-related issues take place. Additionally, capacity building workshops on Community-Based Monitoring tools have been conducted to empower Nari Sangh leaders.



Throughout the year, Nari Sangh leaders have actively engaged in various activities such as conducting CBM in project Gram Panchayats, participating in the development of Gram Panchayat Development Plans, and raising awareness on gender-based violence and human rights through campaigns and celebrations. As a result of these efforts, significant achievements have been made in accessing government schemes, with a large number of individuals benefitting from programs such as PM Awas Yojana,

PM Kisan Samman Nidhi, and Swachh Bharat Mission registration, among others

The commitment of Nari Sangh members and their families to securing their entitlements and actively participating in local governance processes has been a driving force behind the success of the program. Moving forward, the Gramin





Punarnirman Sansthan program aims to continue its efforts in promoting women's empowerment, ensuring inclusive development, and fostering responsible citizenship within the target communities.

Care and Education for 36 Semi-Orphan and Poor Children in VARANASI

The Gramin Punarnirman Sansthan's program "Care and Education for 36 Semi-Orphan and Poor Children in Varanasi" has been a beacon of hope for the marginalized community in the urban slums of Varanasi. Through a dedicated effort to sensitize the community on child rights, the organization has successfully built structures for the protection and improvement of children's circumstances. By providing both formal and non-formal education to 36 orphan children, the program has opened up doors of opportunity that were previously closed to them.



In addition to education, the program has also focused on strengthening community-based health systems, ensuring a healthy environment for these vulnerable children. Through the utilization of indigenous skills and knowledge, better livelihood options have been identified, giving these children a chance at a brighter future. Social advocacy for children's agendas has been a key component, with efforts to mainstream the issue of child rights in government programs.

The program engages with children, youth, and elderly groups in the slums ensuring a holistic approach to community development. NFE Centre Support, home and slum visits, monthly staff meetings, and school visits are just a few of the initiatives undertaken to support these children.



By providing mid-day meals and quality education, 36 orphan children have been empowered to break the cycle of poverty and reach their full potential. The impact of this program will resonate for years to come, transforming the lives of those it serves.

Digital Champions Program

The Gramin Punarnirman Sansthan's Digital Champions Program aims to provide online educational services to students in order to protect them from cyber crime, cyber bullying, and cyber arrest. The program kicked off with a basic teacher orientation and training session



to equip educators with the necessary knowledge and skills. Additionally, the program mapped out five in-person visits to schools to ensure direct engagement with both teachers and students.

Throughout the duration of the program, regular check-ins were conducted with schools to monitor progress and ensure adherence to the curriculum. Teachers were supported in tracking students' progress and motivating them to complete the course successfully. The program also facilitated activities such as program launches, peer learning sessions, and graduation ceremonies, all of which were essential in fostering a safe and secure online environment for the students.



Targeting 1500 students across 15 high schools and intermediate colleges in Atraulia, Ahiraula, and Koilsa blocks of Azamgarh district, the Digital Champions Program has the potential to empower the next generation with crucial knowledge on online safety. By the end of the program, a total of 1702 students are expected to have a better understanding of cyber threats and how to navigate the digital world securely. Through this initiative, the organization aims to create a generation of digitally savvy youth who can protect themselves from potential online dangers.

Scheduled to run from 15th February 2024 to 30th September 2024, the Digital Champions Program is a proactive step towards ensuring that students in rural areas are well-equipped to handle the challenges of the digital age. By engaging with 15 high schools and intermediate colleges, the program demonstrates a commitment to empowering young minds with the knowledge and skills needed to thrive in an increasingly digital world.

Digital classroom Program

The Gramin Punarnirman Sansthan Digital Classroom Program aimed to enhance the learning outcomes of girls students at 5 Kasturba Gandhi Awasiy Balika Vidyalay schools, with a special focus on improving their skills in math, English, and science. Through the implementation of online classes, the program successfully engaged 471 girls students from Atraulia, Koilsa, Ahiraula, Phoolpur, and Pawai districts in Azamgarh. These classes provided a platform for interactive learning and facilitated a conducive environment for students to enhance their knowledge in key subjects.



To further promote interest and enthusiasm in STEM subjects, the program organized celebrations for Science Day and Mathematics Day, highlighting the significance of these fields in education. Additionally, the program commemorated Children's Day and organized a Readathon to encourage a love for reading among the students. These initiatives not only contributed to the academic development of the students but also fostered a holistic approach to education, encouraging a well-rounded growth.



Throughout the duration of the program, which ran from July 2024 to March 2025, the students exhibited high levels of engagement and attendance rates, showcasing their dedication to learning and their eagerness to grasp new concepts. With the support of e-Vidyaloka Trust in English US language, the program successfully created a dynamic and interactive learning environment that not only improved academic

performance but also instilled a love for learning among the students. The outcomes of the program underscored the importance of innovative educational initiatives in empowering students and enhancing their academic achievements.

Community Health Program



health. Through this program, women from the vulnerable community in the aspirational block of Bhiaon district, Ambedkar Nagar, have been brought together to form collectives. These collectives have played a pivotal role in advocating

The Gramin Punarnirman Sansthan's Community Health Program has been an instrumental initiative aimed at amplifying the voices of marginalized women in the prioritization of health planning, enhancing program monitoring, and advocating for accountability in accessing their right to



for their entitlements, with a specific focus on health services.

A key highlight of the program has been the capacity building of Community-Based Organization leaders on various entitlements, empowering them to actively participate in Village Health, Sanitation, and Nutrition Days (VHSND). Additionally, the program has successfully registered and immunized 132 pregnant women during their first trimester, with 10 high-risk pregnancies referred to higher medical institutes for specialized care. Furthermore, a total of 156 children have been immunized under this program, contributing significantly to the overall health outcomes of the community.



Despite facing challenges such as irregular VHSND and limited information about health services and entitlements, the Community Health Program has made significant strides in improving the health and NCD (special focused on cancer) well-being of marginalized women in



the target community. The duration of the program, from June 2024 to March 2025, has seen a positive impact in regularizing supplementary food distribution through Anganwadi Centers, ensuring nutritional support for women and children. Overall, the program has successfully bridged the gap in access to healthcare services and empowered women to demand

their rights, making a lasting impact on the community's health outcomes.

Climate Action Program :Developing Adaptive Capacity to Climate and Water Security Risks for Small and Marginal Farmers in Atraulia Block

In the heart of Azamgarh district, Uttar Pradesh, the Gramin Punarnirman Sansthan has spearheaded a trans formative project aimed at bolstering the resilience and adaptability of small and marginal farmers in the Atraulia block. With a keen focus on mitigating climate-related risks and enhancing water security, the initiative seeks to uplift livelihoods and ensure food security for the local farming communities.



Over the course of the project, significant milestones have been achieved to empower farmers and fortify their capacity to tackle

environmental challenges. Water conservation strategies have been meticulously developed and implemented across five Gram Panchayats, fostering sustainable farming practices and efficient resource management. Through a series of meetings and capacity-building sessions, local farmers and stakeholders have been equipped with vital knowledge and skills essential for combating climate change and water scarcity.

Furthermore, the formation of Mahila Kisan Sanghans with the participation of 100 farmers per Gram Panchayat, predominantly women, has been instrumental in fostering community cohesion and promoting gender-inclusive agricultural practices. The cultivation of 10 vermi compost units and the introduction of innovative wheat sowing techniques in 46 acres of paddy fields have not only enhanced productivity but also significantly reduced carbon emissions, demonstrating the project's commitment to environmental stewardship.



In addition, the project has facilitated the adoption of organic farming practices among 150 marginal farmers, imparting crucial training on techniques such as Vermi composting, Beejamrit, and Jeevamrit. Moreover, community awareness on water-efficient agricultural practices and climate-resilient strategies has been elevated, laying the groundwork for sustainable development across the Atrouliya block. As the project continues to unfold from August 2024 to March 2025, the Gramin Punarnirman Sansthan remains steadfast in its mission to empower farmers and foster a future of prosperity and sustainability in rural India.

impact of collective

Sharing Information and Collective Awareness

Women shared the information they received not just for themselves, but for the entire community. When one woman learned about a scheme and successfully applied for it, she would inform her neighbors, relatives, or other women about it.

This created a collective awareness environment, encouraging more women to benefit from the scheme. The sharing of information became a crucial factor in increasing community participation. Women began to feel a sense of shared purpose, realizing they could achieve their goals together. This collaborative approach enabled them to support each other and collectively make decisions.

Key Outcomes:

1. Increased collective awareness and participation.
2. Women supported each other in accessing schemes.
3. Collaborative decision-making empowered women.

This highlights the importance of information sharing and collective action in empowering women and driving positive change in their communities.

Participation in Community Decisions

The impact of this confidence boost encouraged women's participation in community decisions. When one woman saw another's success in a project or initiative, she felt inspired and realized that if others could do it, she could too.

This created a cycle of confidence among women. As one woman achieved success, others were motivated to follow suit. For example, when a woman received assistance for her marriage under the Chief Minister's Collective Marriage Scheme, her story inspired other women.

They thought, "If she can do it, we can too." Women learned from each other, shared their knowledge, and collectively increased their participation in community decisions.

Key Outcomes:

1. Increased confidence and participation in community decisions.
2. Women learned from each other's successes and experiences.
3. Collective action and knowledge-sharing empowered women.

This highlights the power of women's empowerment and collective action in driving positive change in their communities.

Increased participation of women in collective decision-making.

Through the group, awareness grew that women are not limited to just the home, but they can also play a significant role in societal and community decision-making. As women began to benefit from government schemes, they realized they could be equal participants in decision-making.

Women in the community started openly discussing issues related to education, health, and employment. For instance, when a woman noticed difficulties in disseminating information about the village health center, she gathered other women and launched a joint campaign.

This collective decision not only improved access to health services but also demonstrated women's active participation in the community.

1. Increased awareness and participation in decision-making.
2. Women became equal partners in community development.
3. Collective action improved access to services.
